| Every person at BFS has the right to non-violent resolutions of issues and conflicts.                 | Every person has the responsibility to attempt to resolve conflicts and to discuss issues peacefully.  |
| Every person in the School has the right to be treated fairly and with integrity.                     | Everyone has the responsibility to treat others fairly and with honesty.   |
